This is in response to your email of October 8, 2015 wherein you were seeking the acceptability of the subject lubricants to be used on non-food contact surfaces in food processing establishments.

Based on the information submitted, we can advise that we see no reason to object to the composition and use of these products as proposed in food processing establishments provided that:

- a) They are only used on **non-food contact surfaces** where there is no contact of the lubricants with food, as stated on the labels; and
- b) They are used in the minimum amount required to achieve their intended technical effect.

We trust that the foregoing will be of use to you.
